1. Study Goal App

Download the Study Goal App from

- App Store
- Google play
- Your preferred App store





2. Getting started

Identify yourself as a student at Greenwich

- Open the app
 - Select student
 - Choose University of Greenwich





3. Logging on for the first time

- Log in using your University ID and password.
- Select the student tab and sign on again with your University ID and Password.

Once setup the app will be single sign on – so you only have to do this once
