

Open Day FAQs

Greenwich campus

How do I get to Greenwich campus?

There are multiple ways you can travel to Greenwich:

- By Docklands Light Railway (DLR) to Greenwich Cutty Sark (approx. 3 min walk)
- By train to either Greenwich or Maze Hill stations (approx. 8 min walk)
- By river boat to Greenwich Pier (3 min walk)
- By bus. Check [Greenwich](#) or [Transport for London](#) websites for more information.
- By car. Public 'Pay and display' [car parks nearby](#).
- By campus bus. Campus bus service operates between campuses. Catch the campus bus in front Dreadnought Building from 10:00 till 15:30, every hour.

How do I check-in?

You can check-in from 9.30am on the day of the event at the entrance of:

- **Stockwell Street building**, for School of Design subjects
- **Queen Anne building (marque outside)**, for Greenwich Business School, School of Law & Criminology, School of Humanities & Social Sciences subjects
- **King William building**, for School of Computing & Mathematics Sciences subjects
- **Dreadnought building (stretch tents outside)**, for School of Education, and School of Human Science subjects.

To help manage queues and for safety measures, within your 'important information' email you will have an assigned check-in point. Please use this allocated check-in point as this will also be close to your selected subject sessions.

After the check-in, you will receive your visitor lanyard for access into buildings and a free light food/refreshment voucher.

What about COVID Safety?

The safety of our guests, students and staff is our highest priority and following recent UK Government guidelines new requirements are in place.

Upon arrival, please demonstrate Covid status by providing proof of one of the following:

- A negative NHS rapid lateral flow test was taken within 48 hours of the event
- Full vaccination (first and second dose) with the second dose administered at least 14 days before the Open Day.
- If you are a UK attendee, you can show your vaccination or test results via the NHS Covid Pass app.

We strongly encourage all our visitors to keep a 2m distance and frequently wash their hands and use our hand sanitising stations.

The Welcome talk for Greenwich Business School can be found in the Queen Anne Building.

The Welcome talk for Faculty of Education, Health & Human Sciences in the Stephen Lawrence Building.

What else can I do?

You can:

- Go on student-led campus and accommodation tours (Location: stretch tent outside Dreadnought)
- Meet the Students' Union (Location: Dreadnought building - Lower Deck)
- Talk to our friendly support staff about application process, fees & funding, wellbeing, student accommodation, and our careers & employability service (Location: Dreadnought building)

Do I need to pre-book the student and campus tours?

You do need to pre-book the tours, as there are limited spaces available. If you are planning to go on any for the tours, please go up to the dedicated stands and book your slot in. Please note only 6 people per accommodation tour and only 12 people per campus tour.

How can I get from one campus to the other?

You can use our University of Greenwich bus service to travel between all three campuses.
