Our International Postgraduate Certificate in Education (iPGCE) is a global teacher education qualification for practitioners who want to gain a recognised international qualification for teaching in an early years, primary, a secondary or equivalent educational context. The iPGCE will enable you to develop your professional competency, as a creative and inclusive educator, through critical reflection and research in a national and global context.

Our online course is designed to develop your teaching skills and knowledge when working with a diverse student body. You will need to be teaching or supporting teaching in a formal education setting (voluntary or paid) throughout the course.

After completion of the course, you can use 60 credits towards completing a part-time or a full-time Master's in Education through our Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) process. It can also be used with our UK Assessment Only Route to Qualified Teacher Status (QTS), if you are suitably qualified and experienced.
