

GREAT India Scholarships 2019-20

Terms and Conditions

- 1. Applicants must be Indian passport holders and resident in India at the time of application.
- 2. Applicants must have completed their secondary education in India.
- 3. Applicants must already hold an offer to study with the University of Greenwich for September 2019.
- 4. Scholarships are only available for select full time undergraduate degree programmes and postgraduate taught programmes for the 19/20 academic year. Eligible programmes include:
 - Computer Science (Cyber Security), BSc Hons
 - Architecture, BA Hons
 - Psychology with Counselling, BSc Hons
 - Global Public Health, MSc
 - International and Commercial Law, LLM
- 5. Applicants must be fee assessed as overseas.
- 6. University of Greenwich International College (UGIC) students, progressing to the University component of their course, will not be considered.
- 7. Applicants must be a registering on a degree programme at the University of Greenwich for the first time and not be in receipt of any other award such as a bursary or scholarship of any kind.
- 8. The scholarship is not transferrable. Therefore, if you defer, interrupt or transfer from your Course to another course, your scholarship cannot be transferred.
- 9. For undergraduate students, the scholarship covers the first academic year of study only. Students must pay the full cost of tuition in subsequent years of study.
- 10. Selected scholars will need to make their own financial arrangements for the boarding, living and all other on-campus expenses
- 11. Recipients of this award will be required to participate in University promotional and marketing activities, such as providing testimonials, featuring in videos and attendance at University events.
- 12. Recipients of this award will be expected to act as an international brand ambassador for the University of Greenwich.
