

Open Day FAQs

Medway campus

How do I get to Medway campus?

There are multiple ways you can travel to our Medway campus, which is in Chatham in Kent:

- By train to Chatham Station (approx. 5 min by bus)
- by train to Gillingham Station (approx. 20 min walk / 10 min by bus)
- By car. Parking on-campus for permit holders with option to pay-as-you-go.
- By campus bus. Campus bus service operates from Greenwich from 10am, 12pm, 2:30pm, and from Medway from 11am, 1:30pm, 3:30pm.

Check [Medway bus services](#) to know which bus to take from train stations to the campus.

How do I check-in?

You can check-in from 9.30am on the day of the event at the Pilkington Building by presenting your ticket. There, you will receive your visitor lanyard for access into buildings and a free light food/refreshment voucher.

What about COVID Safety?

The safety of our guests, students and staff is our highest priority and following recent UK Government guidelines new requirements are in place.

Upon arrival, please demonstrate Covid status by providing proof of one of the following:

- A negative NHS rapid lateral flow test was taken within 48 hours of the event
- Full vaccination (first and second dose) with the second dose administered at least 14 days before the Open Day.
- If you are a UK attendee, you can show your vaccination or test results via the NHS Covid Pass app.

We strongly encourage all our visitors to keep a 2m distance and frequently wash their hands and use our hand sanitising stations.

After arrival, please go to Pilkington building to check-in. There, you will also meet our student ambassadors who will be able to take you to the subject sessions. This is where you will meet your future teaching staff and take part in informative talks and sessions. The Welcome talk for Faculty of Engineering and Science will take place in our Pilkington Building.

You can:

- Go on student-led campus and accommodation tours (Location: gazebo outside of Pilkington Building)
- Visit Drill Hall library
- Meet the Students’ Union (Location: The Deep End)
- Talk to our friendly support staff about application process, fees & funding, wellbeing, student accommodation, and our careers & employability service (Location: Pilkington Building)
