A CAS number confirms to UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) that we wish to sponsor your study in the UK. A Biometric Residence Permit (BRP) is a secure identity card that contains personal details and biometric information. It is your visa and is proof of your right to be in the UK as a student.
