University of Greenwich

The University of Greenwich graduates recognised in these international awards ceremonies follow a long line of successful students who have completed their awards since the foundation of the institution in 1890.

From the early days as an institution serving its local community in south-east London, particularly the engineering and science needs of local industry and the nearby military arsenal, the university is now an international institution with links across the world in teaching, consultancy, and research.

The University of Greenwich now ranks in the top 100 institutions in the Times Higher Impact Rankings, measuring global universities' success in delivering the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals.

And it is the 8th best institution in the UK based on the People & Planet University League for our environmental and ethical performance.

The University of Greenwich has a long tradition of welcoming international students. They form an important student group enriching the life of their faculties, and we are rightly proud of our international graduates. The University of Greenwich is the 5th in the UK for delivering degrees around the world. Of the 21,759 students at the university, 30% are international students from over 170 different countries. In addition, we have 13,981 students studying our programmes in their home country at one of our collaborative partner institutions.

Hong Kong has for many years provided important partnerships for the university with, as the ceremonies demonstrate, a substantial proportion of our international graduates coming from our successful partnerships with institutions in Hong Kong.

Students at the university benefit from the up-to-date and relevant curricula of our degrees, which provide a foundation for employment or study for higher degrees.

Some of our graduates would have been based at our Greenwich Campus in Sir Christopher Wren's masterpiece buildings that form the Old Royal Naval College, others in the Edwardian red-brick buildings of the Medway Campus that is also a former Royal Naval site and some would have enjoyed both studying and living in the modern student village that is our Avery Hill Campus.

Most graduates here today would have completed their degrees locally at one of the university's partner institutions. Greenwich is proud to have been at the forefront of the development of such in-country provision (now labelled "Transnational Education") and fortunate to have the quality partners that it does to deliver its programmes locally.

Through its quality assurance procedures, the university is confident that the standard of attainment of its locally based students is fully equivalent to that of its UK-based students. The university recognises the special importance of these ceremonies to its transnational students. It welcomes the opportunity they provide for senior staff to meet successful graduates face to face and applaud their achievement.

Graduates in these ceremonies now hold their internationally recognised awards from the University of Greenwich. We hope that they, their families, and friends will take pride in this achievement and that the graduates will wish to stay in touch with their university through the local alumni associations active in Hong Kong. These awards ceremonies reflect the high achievement of the graduates resulting from their link with the university in the past few years, but they should also mark the beginning of an association lasting the rest of their lives.

A selection of our gowns



Doctor of Philosophy

This is a traditional-style gown in gold damask, with fronts and sleeves trimmed with the university's scarlet woven silk. There is a blue cord and button on each sleeve and on the back of the yoke. The hood is in gold damask with the university's blue damask on the inside top edge. The hat is a gold damask tudor bonnet with blue tassel.

The Doctor of Education gown is similar to that of the Doctor of Philosophy, but the yoke is the university's blue damask with gold cord and button, and the cape is edged with the university's blue silk.



Taught Master's degrees

Holders of the Master of Arts, Master of Business Administration, Master of Engineering and Master of Science degrees wear a traditional black gown with long hanging sleeves. The hood is in blue damask lined with the university's scarlet woven silk. The cape is edged with plain scarlet silk and the hat is a black cloth mortar board.

Non-university awards

A traditional black gown is worn with no hood. The hat is a black cloth mortar board.



Integrated Master's Degree

Holders of Master of Architecture, Master of Chemistry, Master of Engineering, and Master of Physics degrees wear a traditional black gown with long hanging sleeves. The hood has a black outer, full shape and fully lined with university gold damask, with the university's scarlet woven silk on the inside top edge. The hat is a black cloth mortar board.



Bachelor's degrees

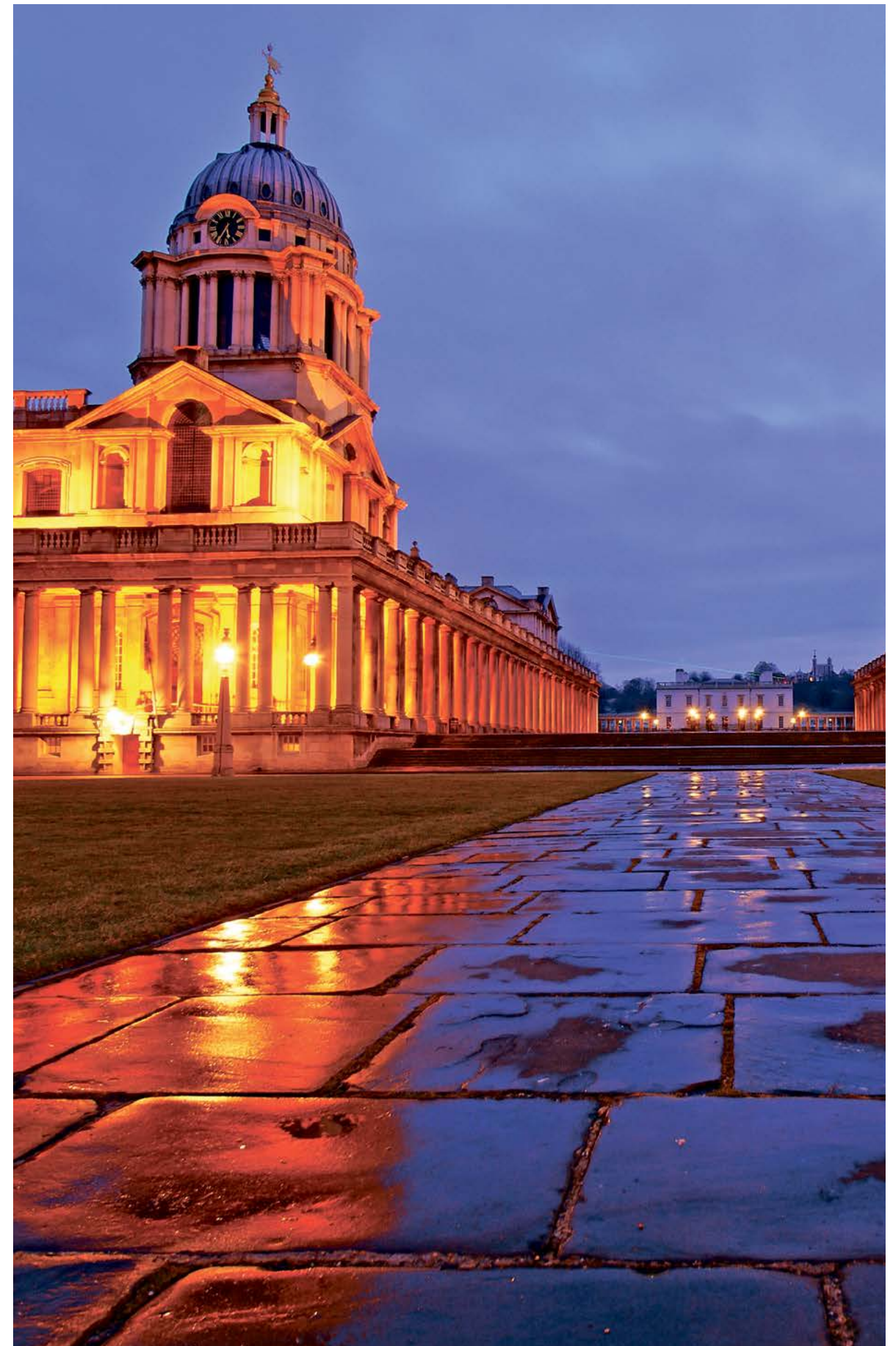
The gown is the traditional black gown with sleeves, worn rather shorter than Masters' gowns. The hood is black art silk outer, full shape and part-lined with the university's scarlet woven silk and blue damask. The hat is a black cloth mortar board.



Foundation degrees

A traditional black gown is worn. The hood is black art silk outer, full shape and fully lined with the university's blue damask, with the university's scarlet woven silk on the inside top edge. The hat is a black cloth mortar board.

For diplomas and certificates, a traditional black gown is also worn. The hood is fully lined with blue damask and edged with plain scarlet silk.

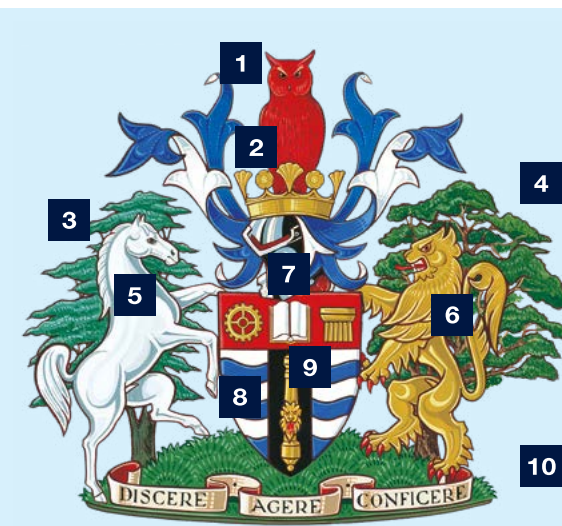

The university's arms

Symbols on our arms recognise our history as a provider of education in the South East for a hundred years and reflect the different institutions that have come together to form today's university. These symbols include:

- 1 The owl, a traditional representation of wisdom.
- 2 The coronet, with shells and rosettes from the Avery Hill College badge.
- 3 The cedar tree, from the badge of Madame Bergman-Österberg's College at Dartford, and
- 4 the oak tree, from the coat of arms of Quintin Hogg, who opened Woolwich Polytechnic in 1890.
- 5 The White Horse of Kent and
- 6 the Lion of London, which indicate the locations of our campuses.
- 7 From left to right, the engineers' wheel, which figured on both the Woolwich Polytechnic Arms and the Garnett College badge; the book, symbolising study and learning; and the doric column, representing the Hammersmith College of Building and Art and our own School of Architecture, Design & Construction.
- 8 The waves, evoking the Thames and featured on the Woolwich Polytechnic arms, the Garnett College badge and the arms of the Greater London Council and the Inner London Education Authority.
- 9 The cannon, from the Woolwich Polytechnic's Arms.
- 10 Our motto, encapsulating the purpose of the university for its students: **'To Learn, To Do, To Achieve'**.
