International Scholarship Award 2021/22

Terms and Conditions

- Applicants must have been offered a place on a full-time undergraduate degree programme or full time postgraduate taught programme for the 2021/22 academic year.
- Applicants must have been assessed by the University of Greenwich as requiring to pay international fees.
- Applicants must be a registering on a degree programme at the University of Greenwich for the first time and not be in receipt of any other award such as a bursary or scholarship of any kind. For graduates of the University we offer a separate <u>alumni scholarship</u>.
- Applicants may only apply when the International Scholarship Awards scheme is open and where the panel is able to reach a decision to approve an award to the applicant **before their course start date**.
- University of Greenwich International College (UGIC) students, progressing to the University component of their course, are eligible to apply.
- The scholarship is awarded for the first academic year of study only, in the form of a tuition fee discount.. Students must pay the full cost of tuition in subsequent years of study.
- Students will be eligible for scholarship awards with a value of up to £3,000.
- Recipients of this award are expected to participate in University promotional activities, such as interviews and attendance at University events.
- EU national students, domiciled in the EU are not eligible for this award. If you are in this category, you will be eligible for another award, which we will communicate to you in due course.
- The application must be completed and submitted electronically using the form below. Handwritten and scanned copies will not be accepted.
- Any applications submitted after the published deadline will not be considered.
- Individuals may only apply once for this scholarship and the decision of the panel is final.
- Due to the high volume of applications we receive, we are unable to provide detailed individual feedback.
