The High Achievement Scholarship - 2019-20 – Awarding and Assessment Process

A scholarship of up to £2,000 for one year only, paid in three instalments for new undergraduate full time and part time home students entering their first year of study – Year 0 or 1.

Part time students will receive a scholarship of £1,000 paid in two equal instalments

Eligibility Criteria

- Undertaking an Undergraduate degree and new to the University in 2019/2020
- Studying at one of our three campuses: Greenwich, Avery Hill, Medway (except Medway School of Pharmacy) or one of our Partner Colleges
- If studying with a Partner College the tuition fees must be paid directly to the University of Greenwich
- Undertaking a BA/BEd/BSc/LLB/BEng/MEng or MMath programme
- 200 plus UCAS tariff points from level 3 qualifications (as your highest qualification)
- Grade B (or Grade 6) or above in GCSE Maths and English
- Paying the maximum tuition fee of £9,250
- Part time students must be undertaking at least 60 credits in their first year of study Year 0 or 1.

Assessment/Awarding Process

- Assessment will be carried out automatically. Students need not apply to the university.
- Details of students who have met the academic criteria will be sent to Student Finance and Financial Support team.
- Student Finance and Financial Support will check that students that meet academic merit, also meet wider eligibility.
- The assessment process for the first payment will be carried out from 1st November 2019.
- The assessment process for the second payment will be carried out from 1st February 2020.
- The assessment process for the third payment will be carried out from 1st April 2019
- The first payment will be paid to the student by 8th December 2019.
- The second payment will be paid to the student by 1st March 2020.
- The third payment will be paid to the student by April 26th 2020.
- The payment will be made via the Student Finance payments portal.
- You will be contacted by the Student Finance and Financial Support team to confirm their award.
- The award will be paid in the following instalments, £660, £660 and £680.

To receive a second and/or final payment you must remain registered and in attendance on their program at the University of Greenwich
