

GREat Skills Scholarship 2023-2024

Deadline for nominations: Midnight on Friday 24 May 2024

This nomination form is for the GREat Skills Scholarship and **must** only be submitted by a teacher or adviser working in the nominated students' school, college, or other partner institution.

A student would be eligible for nomination for the scholarship if they have taken part in our outreach activities during their level 3 qualifications and will be joining us for UG studies from September 2024. They also must demonstrate the positive impact which participation in these activities has had on their current studies and in preparing them forfuture studies, by detailing this in the section below.

Students would also need to meet the following criteria to be nominated to receive the GREat Skills Scholarship:

- Students will need to be studying at one of our <u>targeted schools and colleges</u> and must be nominated by a member of staff.
- Students need to be studying level 3 qualifications (A level, BTEC Level 3, T Levels, Access, IB or any other Level 3 qualifications) which hold UCAS points and will be receiving their final results in the Summer 2024.
- Students need to have received an offer to study a full-time undergraduate course (including extended programmes) at our Greenwich, Avery Hill or Medway Campus (excluding the Medway School of Pharmacy), which commences in September 2024.
- Students will be a new full-time undergraduate, paying the maximum tuition fee of £9,250
- Students need to have participated in a minimum of 5 of our outreach activities, of which 3 must be physical/in-person and 3 must be from GREat Skills/Big Ideas as main attendance. Other interactions can include (please see below table):
