The Postgraduate Researcher Development Programme (PGRDP) is the university's approach to personal development and skills training of postgraduate research students (PGRs).

PGRDP: Strand 1 – Introduction to Research Skills – All PGRs are required to complete all the sessions and online courses. You are required to engage with this strand at the first available opportunity following your registration as a postgraduate research student with the university and complete your training within your first year of study for full-time (FT) students and within your first two years of study for part-time (PT) students. All PGRs are required to undertake both half-day sessions in the same term/month where possible. Existing students who have partially completed the Strand should attend individual sessions.
