Terms of Reference

- To control the management of the Joint Venture, determine policy to attain the Joint Venture objects, and make decisions on the Matters of Principle in relation to the Joint Venture
- To oversee the strategy and policies associated with the Universities at Medway Initiative, including the development of the academic programmes, physical facilities and support services.

- To have oversight of the operational decision-making delegated to the Campus Management Board and other related committees/working groups such as Joint Academic Planning Group (JAP) and to provide a forum for the discussion of matters that cannot otherwise be resolved at Campus Management Board/JAP level.
- To receive and review papers and policy documents as recommended by the Campus Management Board and its various sub-committees or working groups in order to inform the Steering Group's strategies as they relate to the Universities at Medway Project.
- To explore opportunities to contribute to the wider social, economic and cultural offer within the Thames Gateway regeneration area through the various partnership opportunities available with Government, private and public sector organisations active in the region.
- The Steering Group shall meet on an annual basis with additional ad-hoc meetings arranged if necessary.

Quorum

The quorum for the transaction of business at meetings of the Steering Group shall be 2 members each from the Universities of Kent, Greenwich and Canterbury Christ Church and one representative from Mid Kent College (Principal to nominate an alternate if unable to attend).
